She highlighted the donation we made to support the Black Lives Matter Choir Natural Voice Network Commissioning Project; and the COP26 grant, which was used to support the network in Chile.

Margaret thanked everyone for their support through membership fees. She stressed that fees paid by Bank Transfer eased administration, but equally welcomed cash payments. Neil Duguid was thanked for being on the door every month to collect fees; and Hilary Patrick for agreeing to audit our annual financial statement. Hilary and Neil have agreed to alternate years as auditors.

Acceptance of the report was proposed by Margaret Christie, seconded by Sylvia McGowan and unanimously approved by the membership.

Kathy Jenkins, Chairperson, delivered highlights from her report.

Kathy reminded us of the very moving and inspiring report presented last year by Hilery Williams, who was unable to attend to-day. Over the year, as Covid restrictions have partially eased, we have progressed from: monthly zoom sessions; to socially distanced rehearsals outside at the Bellfield Hub, Portobello; to meeting inside for the first time in two years. We first met in person at St Augustine's Church, and today at Broughton St Mary's Church. Kathy expressed our thanks to both Church Committees for allowing and

supporting us to use their facilities. Thanks also to Penny Stone and all our song leaders, for their invaluable and time consuming research into safe singing.

We have been able to celebrate singing in the streets again, in solidarity with a number of causes, raising awareness to make the world a better place. Kathy expressed her thanks for to all the committee members, and especially to Margaret Bremner for taking on the role of Treasurer again, also to Chris Pearson and Chris Booth for keeping our website going.
